Hess donates to Land Trust

The Hess Collection Winery is donating nearly \$3,000 to The Land Trust of Napa County via the environmental charity 1% For the Planet. Founded in 1976, The Land Trust now protects over 50,000 acres of open space and agricultural lands in Napa County, and provides educational programs about agriculture and the natural environment to more than 2,300 students each year. The check will be presented on September 27, at a Hess-sponsored event — Party in the Grove — at the nearby Archer Taylor Preserve, a 380-acre property on Mount Veeder that is owned by The Land Trust. The Hess Collection is sponsoring The Party in the Grove on Saturday, September 27, from 2 to 6 p.m. All proceeds will benefit The Land Trust of Napa County. Held under the towering Redwoods of Archer Taylor Preserve, it will feature a BBQ by the Hess Collection's executive chef Chad Hendrickson paired with Hess wines, followed by a silent auction and Zydeco music and dancing.
